It is developed through a painstaking process involving the Board of Trustees (BoT), staff, and friends of the organization, and relied on diligent SWOT analysis. Although the plan is set to guide programme implementation and other areas of work up to 2025, it is in reality a living document that would be reviewed and amended as the situation warrants.

Purpose of Strategic plan



Current situation

Nigeria is experiencing a double burden of communicable and non-communicable diseases. Over the past two decades' progress has been made in the control of communicable diseases especially HIV, TB, Malaria, and vaccine-preventable diseases due to donor support. On the contrary, the burden of NCDs is rising along with the high prevalence of the risk factors.

Access to health care is inequitable and financed mostly out of pocket, undermining Universal Health Coverage.

The primary care level is the weakest and mostly non-responsive to the needs of the people due to issues of human resources for health (number and capacity), equipment, essential medicines, and physical structures, amongst others for decades to the detriment of UHC. This situation has bred deep-seated apathy that leaves people with no option than to seek care at higher levels. The ripple effect of this poor access to primary health care in the communities leads to overburdened secondary and tertiary levels and ultimately health system failure resulting in poor management of diseases and the worst outcomes.
